



Hello Argentina

Argentina is located in the southern extreme of South America, and borders with Chile, Bolivia, Paraguay, Brazil and Uruguay. Its landscape offers a great contrast between massive oriental plains and the imposing Cordillera de Los Andes in the West, with the highest summit in the Americas: Aconcagua with an altitude of almost 3,000 ft. In the stretch from Jujuy to Tierra del Fuego, the mountain range presents remarkable landscapes, from the north-western plateau to the lake region to the glaciers of the Patagonian Andes.. This is why Argentina is called "The country of the six continents".

Argentina offers a wide variety of climates: subtropical in the North, sub-Antarctic in the southern Patagonia, and mild and humid in the Pampas plains. Median temperature from November to March is 49° F, and 27° F from June to September
