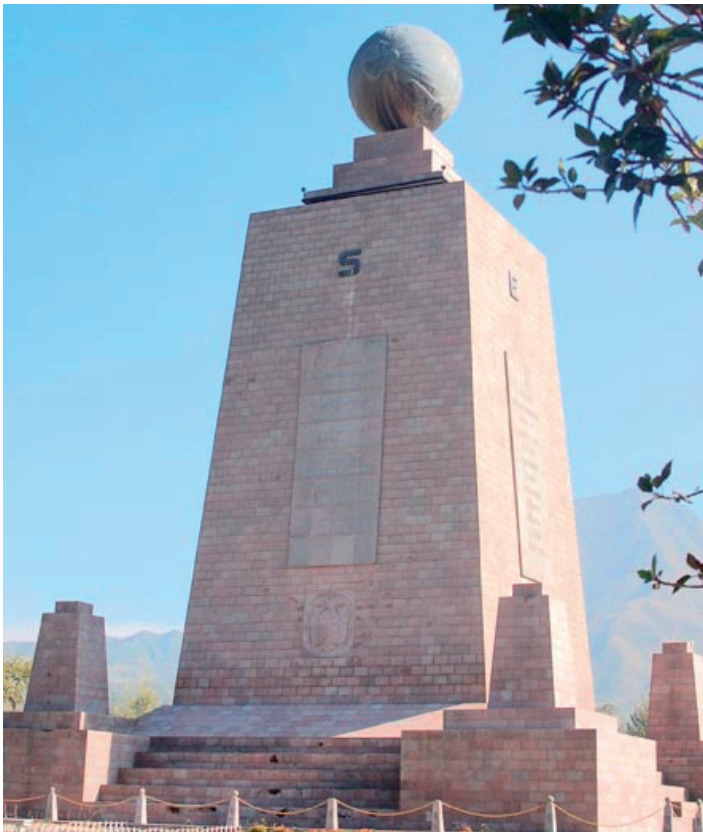




Hello Ecuador

Ecuador is bordered by Colombia on the north, by Peru on the east and south, and by the Pacific Ocean to the west. It is one of only two countries in South America (with Chile) that does not have a border with Brazil. The country also includes the Galápagos Islands in the Pacific, about 600 miles west of the mainland. Ecuador straddles the equator, from which it takes its name, and has an area of 98,985 mi². Its capital city is Quito; its largest city is Guayaquil. Generally speaking, Ecuador has two seasons, wet and dry, but local weather patterns vary greatly depending on geography.
