# Hello Brazil

Brazil covers almost half of the continent and shares a border with almost every other country in South America; only Chile and Ecuador are untouched. The fifth largest country in the world, behind Russia, Canada, China, and the USA, with an area of more than three million square miles, only slightly smaller than the US..

**Cities:** Capital – Brasilia (pop. 2.5 million). Other cities – Sao Paulo (10.9 million), Rio de Janeiro (6.1 million), Belo Horizonte (2.4 million), Salvador (2.9 million), Fortaleza (2.4 million), Recife (1.5 million), Porto Alegre (1.4 million), Curitiba (1.8 million).

**Terrain:** Dense forests in northern regions include the Amazon Basin; semiarid along northeast coast; mountains, hills, and rolling plains in the southwest, including Mato Grosso; Midwestern savannahs; the world’s largest wetland area; and coastal lowland.

**Climate:** Mostly tropical or semitropical with temperate zone in the south

 US citizens require a visa which must be obtained in advance. US residents with non-US passport must consult with the Brazilian Consulate or Embassy.
