



North Pantanal 5 Days / 4 Nights

Day 1 Cuiabá > Pousada Rio Mutum

Arrival at Cuiabá Airport, where you will be met and transferred to the pousada. The staff will serve you a welcome drink and give you an orientation of the lodge and the upcoming program.

Day 2 Pantanal

After breakfast, and depending on the season, you will be taken to view one of the largest gatherings of birds in the whole region, or take an ecological hike through the wilderness of the Pantanal, visiting settlements of the native “caboclos” and their palm-thatched huts, offering a great opportunity to interact with the local culture. After lunch at the Pousada, take an afternoon boat-tour to view the sunset and after dark see crocodiles and other night-active animals by searchlight. Horse trekking is also available, as well as Piranha fishing.

Day 3 Pantanal

After breakfast, take a boat ride and a walking trail to an area that has miles of scenic trails with a knowledgeable guide. Lunch at the lodge. In the afternoon, take a car or boat for a photographic safari to observe the wildlife of the Pantanal.

Day 4 Chapada dos Guimarães

After breakfast, transfer to Chapada dos Guimarães, where you will be driven through this national park, reminiscent of the American Southwest. Some of the attractions in the park are Bridal Veil Falls and the Cidade de Pedra. Overnight at the Hotel Penhasco or Solar do Inglês.

Day 5 Cuiabá to the USA or your next destination in Brazil

After breakfast, check-out and transfer to Cuiabá. Along the way, the transfer also serves as a photo-safari, stopping as time permits to take snap some last minute memories before being dropped off at the airport.

Day 1 Campo Grande – Pousada Caiman Ecological Refuge

Arrival at Campo Grande Airport, where you will be met and transferred to the pousada. Dinner and overnight at Pousada Caiman. The staff will give you an orientation of the lodge and the upcoming program.

Day 2 & 3 Pantanal

Activities at Caiman start very early in the morning, taking full advantage of the best portion of the day to observe the wildlife. After that, guests return to the lodge, have lunch and rest. After a relaxing lunch, it is time to go out for an afternoon excursion and enjoy the wonderful local sunset.

Day 4 Pantanal > Bonito

After breakfast, check-out and departure to Bodoquena/Boca da Onça. After lunch continue to Bonito. Dinner and Overnight at Hotel Wetiga.

Day 5 Bonito

After breakfast, visit the Lago Azul Caves then a boat ride through the Sucuri river to further explore the ecological refuge. Dinner and over night at Hotel.

Day 6 Bonito > Campo Grande to the USA or your next destination in Brazil

After breakfast, check-out and transfer to Campo Grande. Along the way, the transfer also serves as a photo-safari, stopping as time permits to take snap some last minute memories before being dropped off at the airport.
